Classroom Rules: Be Kind, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, Be Safe!

The first few weeks of school are spent learning and practicing our classroom rules. You will find several activities in your child's folder that reinforce our classroom rules and Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS). The focus in our classroom is reinforcing and rewarding positive behaviors from students. It is important that we continually review behavior expectations at school (and home) so that the students can learn in a safe and positive school environment. Please take a few minutes to discuss this with your child.

Conduct Calendar and Green Comet Slips: Your child has been given a "green slip" to keep in their pouch. If your child needs reminders about classroom rules and appropriate behavior then they will give me their green slip so we can discuss their behavior and set a goal for improvement. If your child shows improvement with their behavior they can earn their green slip back and color their Conduct Calendar green!

If your child has a difficult day, their Conduct Calendar will be colored red and you will receive a note explaining the situation. If your child receives a note please take time to discuss your child's actions and work to set goals to improve. Please return the note signed the following day. Please keep the calendar in your child's folder for the entire month. This is our method of DAILY communication.

Many parents like to challenge their child by setting a goal to earn a certain number of green days each week. If they meet their goal, then they can earn a reward. Examples of rewards include a special treat with mom, dad, grandma, grandpa, special trip, prize, etc.
