#### Water Bottles:

### Face Masks:

Per our governor's order all students are required to wear face masks while attending school. Please consider sending an <u>extra</u> face mask with your child to keep in their bookbag.

## Lunch Money

Please place lunch money in an envelope or baggie labeled lunch money. Also include your child's name and teacher's name on it. The students will not receive change as the money is kept in their "lunch account." You can add funds and check your child's account balance using PaySchools Central located on the Powers website.

## Green Folder

Your child will be given a green folder on the first day of school. This is where your child's "Comet Communication Calendar" and other correspondence will be placed. Please check the folder **DAILY**. Important notes, lunch money, etc. should be placed in the clear front pocket so your child can turn it in to their classroom teacher. This folder is an easy way for us to communicate on a daily basis.

It would be greatly appreciated if supplies were removed from original packaging (EXCEPT CRAYONS).

#### Homework

Due to Covid-19, we are minimizing materials that travel between home and school. Therefore, it is important to ensure your child is reading 10-15 minutes nightly. Additional information regarding homework will come from your child's homeroom teacher.
